

2006 PESTICIDE APPLICATOR CERTIFICATION TEST SCHEDULE

It is **STRONGLY RECOMMENDED** testers use the field test sites. Tests are given in Des Moines on the first floor of the Wallace Building at the pesticide bureau any day state offices are open. No test is handed out before 9 a.m. or after 3 p.m. Tests are given on a first-come, first-serve basis. TEST SPACE AT THE OFFICE IN DES MOINES IS LIMITED TO LESS THAN 10.

1. Photo ID required. All tests are available at all sites.
2. No test will be handed out **BEFORE** the scheduled starting time or **AFTER** the scheduled closing time.
3. Cancellations. Weather is the most likely reason for change in the schedule. If winter driving is hazardous in your area, please call the PESTICIDE BUREAU at 515-281-5601 or 515-281-8591 to check on any possible change in time or cancellation.
 (The testing location will be notified of any change in the schedule as soon as possible. Call the phone number for the testing location shown on this schedule ONLY to confirm testing or to ask directions to the testing site.)

POINTS TO NOTE

1. A license is issued to a business. It expires every year on December 31.
2. A certification is issued to a person. It has a three-year cycle. The fee may be paid once per year or once every three years.
3. A person is not certified to commercially apply pesticides unless s/he has passed the Core exam AND one category + is employed with a *licensed* commercial pesticide applicator business + all necessary paper work is up to date + all fees are in the Des Moines office.
4. A licensed commercial pesticide applicator business requires at least one person certified as a commercial pesticide applicator + all necessary paper work is up to date + all fees are in the Des Moines office.
5. A person may renew their certification by attending a class each year for each category by December 31. Miss one year in the three- year cycle and must retest. Training starts same year test is passed. OR A person may renew their certification by testing every three years.
6. Records are required for every pesticide application.
7. At our website click on the tab *Pesticide Laws & Rules*. Click on *Pesticide Rules-Chapter 45*. Following are a few requirements a new licensed commercial pesticide applicator business may need to know. Information is also found in the *Core Study Manual*.
 - 45.22(d) Wood-destroying insect inspection.
 - 45.22(6) Report of licensee. (About CIC forms, retention of, transfer of forms with former employees.)
 - 45.22(8) License application—contents. (Licensee reports employee changes immediately.)
 - 45.22(12) Temporary exemption from certification. (New employee. Supervision for 21-days from initial day of employment).
